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2023 Scholarship Award Program Application

General Information about the Scholarship Award Program

The Board of Directors of the Prince George's Cultural Arts Foundation, Inc. plan to award up to six \$2,500 scholarships to students residing in Prince George's County based on the criteria listed below. Scholarship funds must be used for tuition, books, or other approved educational expenses.

Instructions and Criteria for Applying for Awards

- 1. Applicants must reside in Prince George's County, or the District of Columbia and be a graduating senior, or a prospective or current undergraduate college student. Graduate students are ineligible to apply.
- 2. Applicants must be pursuing an undergraduate degree in the performing arts including music, dance, theatre, or other performing arts at an accredited college and/or university in the United States.
- 3. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average out of a possible 4.0.
- Applicants must submit the required application form electronically to the Prince George's Cultural Arts Foundation Scholarship Committee, Scholarship Committee Chair at <u>scholarship@lakearborjazz.com</u>. Completed applications may also be mailed to:

<u>Applicants must</u> include all required documents. Incomplete applications and applications received by mail after the application deadline will not be considered.

- 5. Applicant must submit a minimum 500 word, maximum 1,000-word essay explaining his/her need and intended use for the scholarship. You may choose your essay from <u>one</u> of the following questions:
 - Why do you want to be a musician/performer/artist? **OR**
 - Which one aspect of visual arts or the performing arts has motivated/inspired you? **OR**
 - Which one historical or contemporary musician, artist or actor do you admire and why? **OR**
 - Given unlimited opportunity and resources, how would you go about making your community a great place for the study, performance, or expansion of the arts?
- 6. An official transcript(s) from the applicant's most recent school must accompany this application.
- 7. Applicant must provide a minimum of two written statements by appropriate academic officials addressing the student's academic achievement.
- 8. Applicant must provide at least two character references.
- 9. Applicants currently receiving a full academic scholarship are ineligible to apply.
